Create a binder or folder that will keep all of your papers organized.

Some important documents to have:

- · Registration papers · Health certificates
- · Show rules
- · Schedules
- · Copies of entry forms

Structural Correctness

- · Take note of the book and boof placement
- The heifer should be strong when her foot





HOOF ROT

CATTLE HEALTH

An infection caused by bacteria in the ground that enters the hoof through puncture wounds or continuous exposure to wet conditions

- Lameness · Foul odor coming from hoof
- · Swelling of interdigital space

TREATMENT?

- An iodine spray (early stages)
- · A topical treatment · Try to keep animal in dry area

- 5. Base width




